This guide provides a detailed step-by-step approach to using QComposite in Easy Mode. Here you work with one of your precreated QLayout templates and simply created the composites without applying any changes to the template design.

1 Click the Easy Mode.

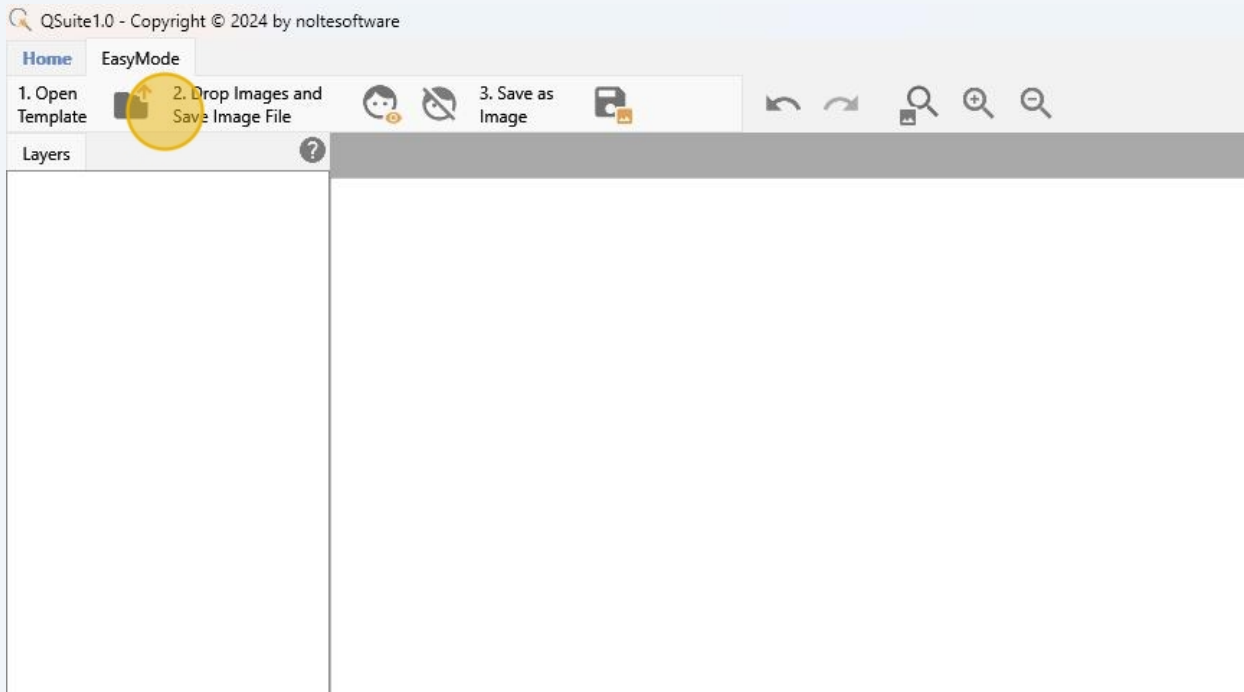

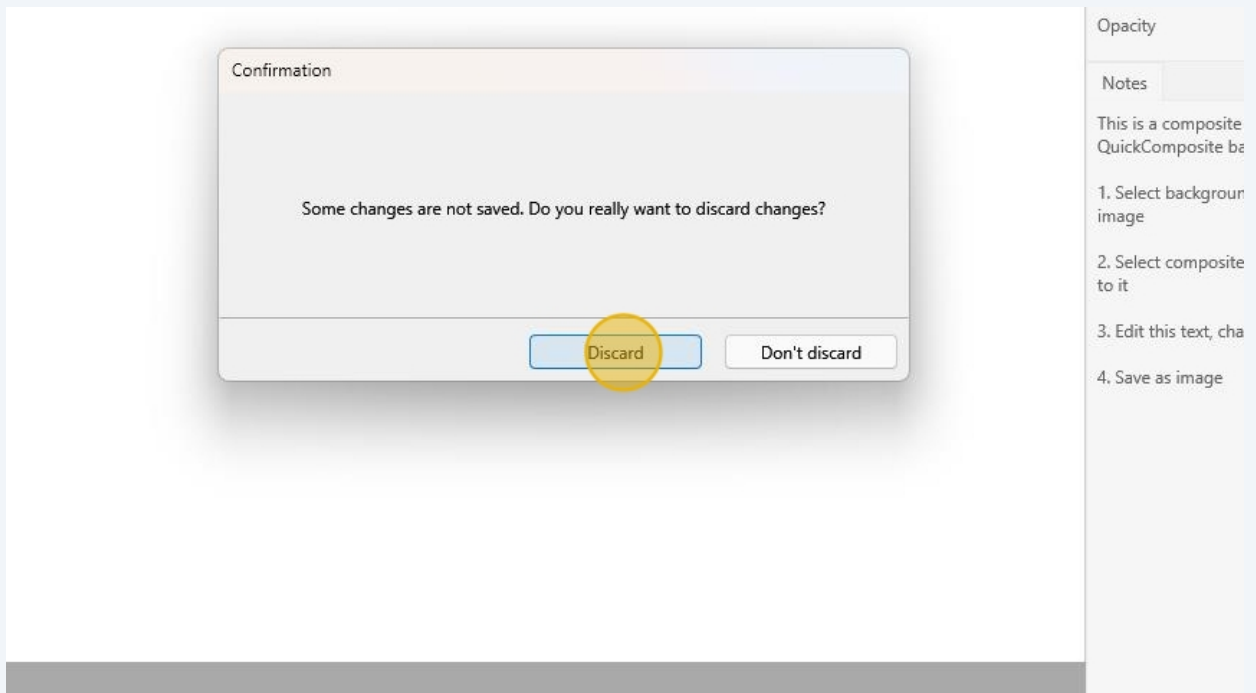

2 Click Open Template.

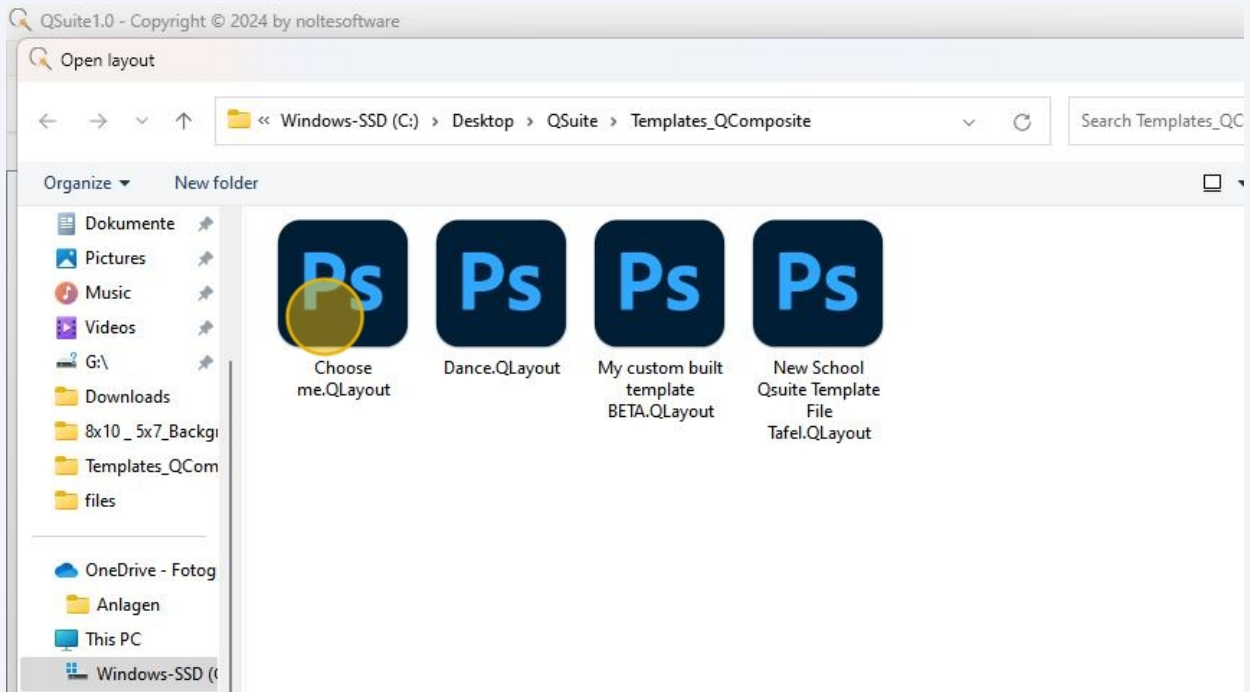


3 Click "Discard" in case you have worked another document before and saved your work.



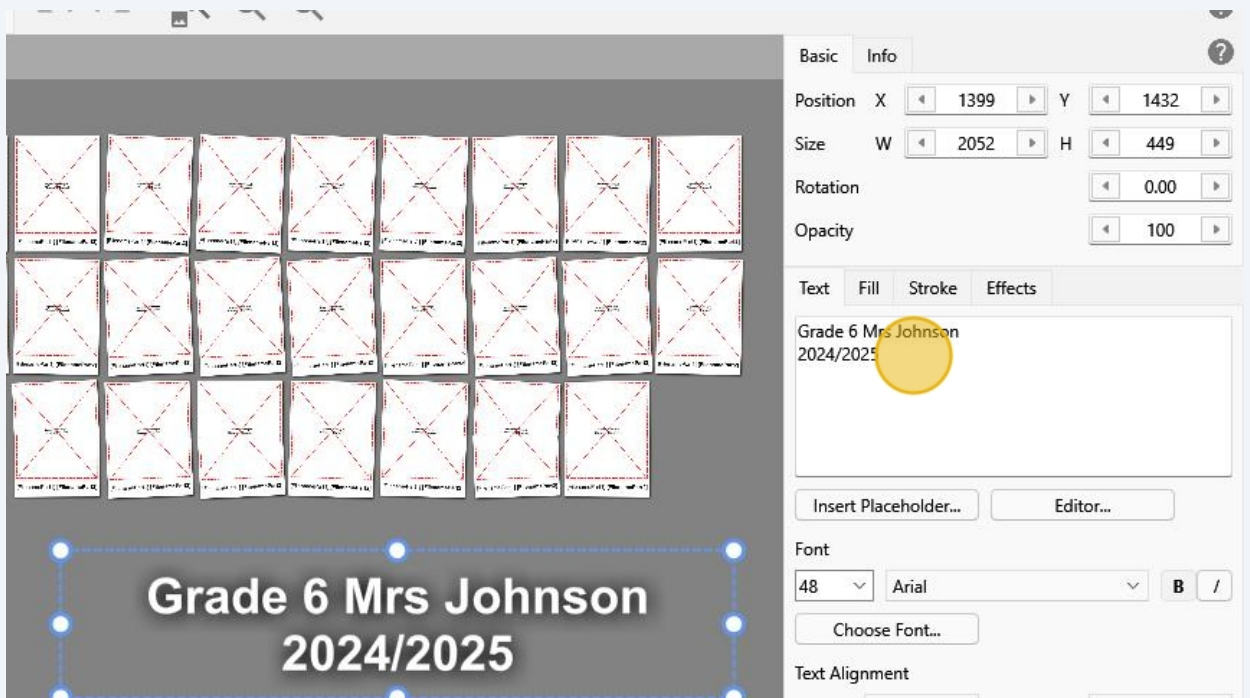

Select the QLayout file from your device. Every time you save a template under the Standard mode, it will be saved as a QLayout file.



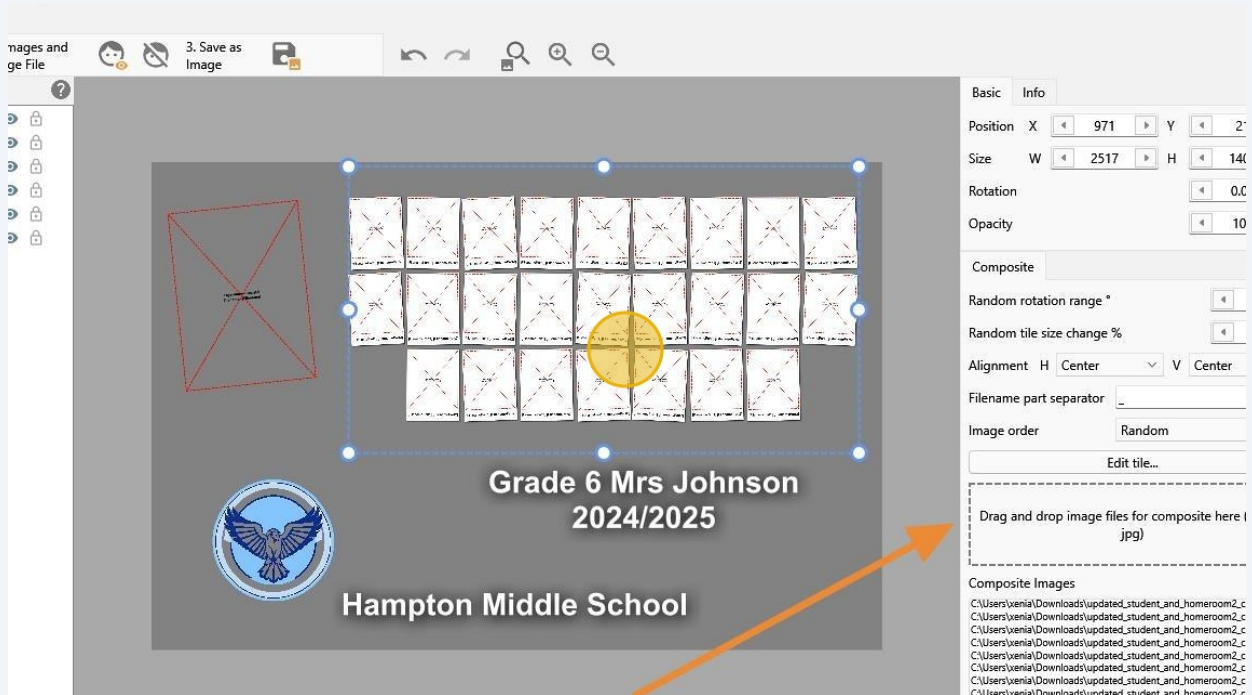

Adjust the text layers under the text properties so it matches the current class / homeroom you're working in.



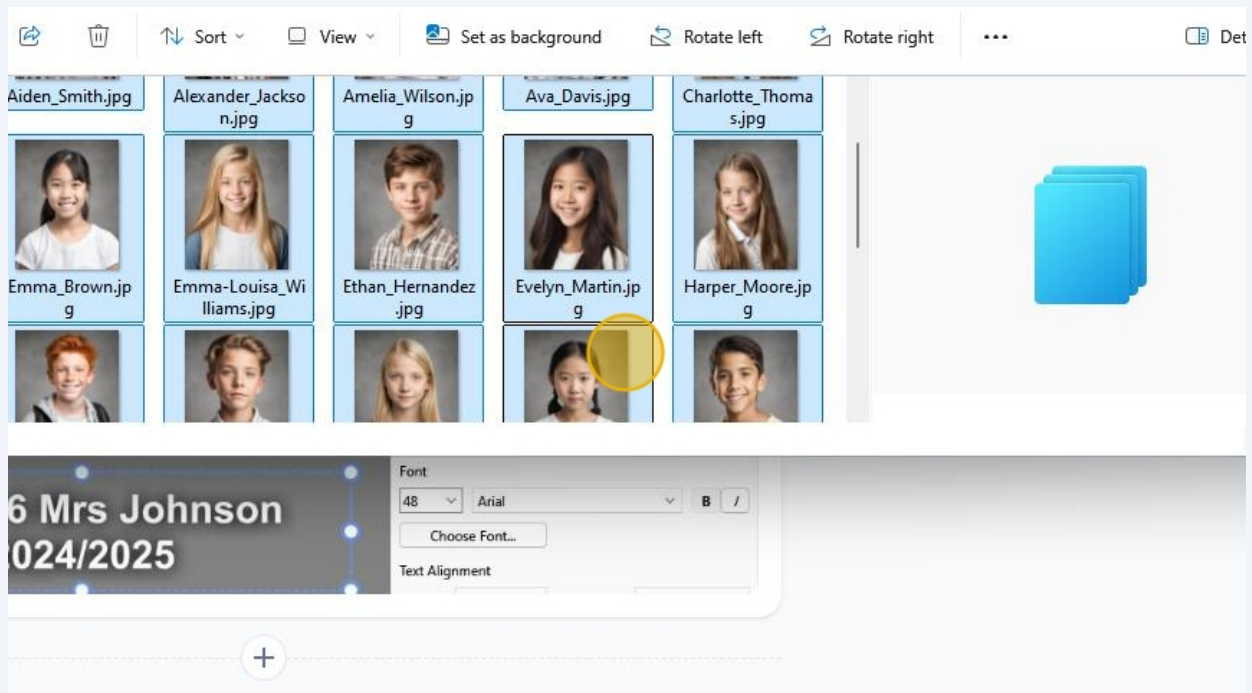

Click the students' composite layer and drop the students' image files. If your template shows names.



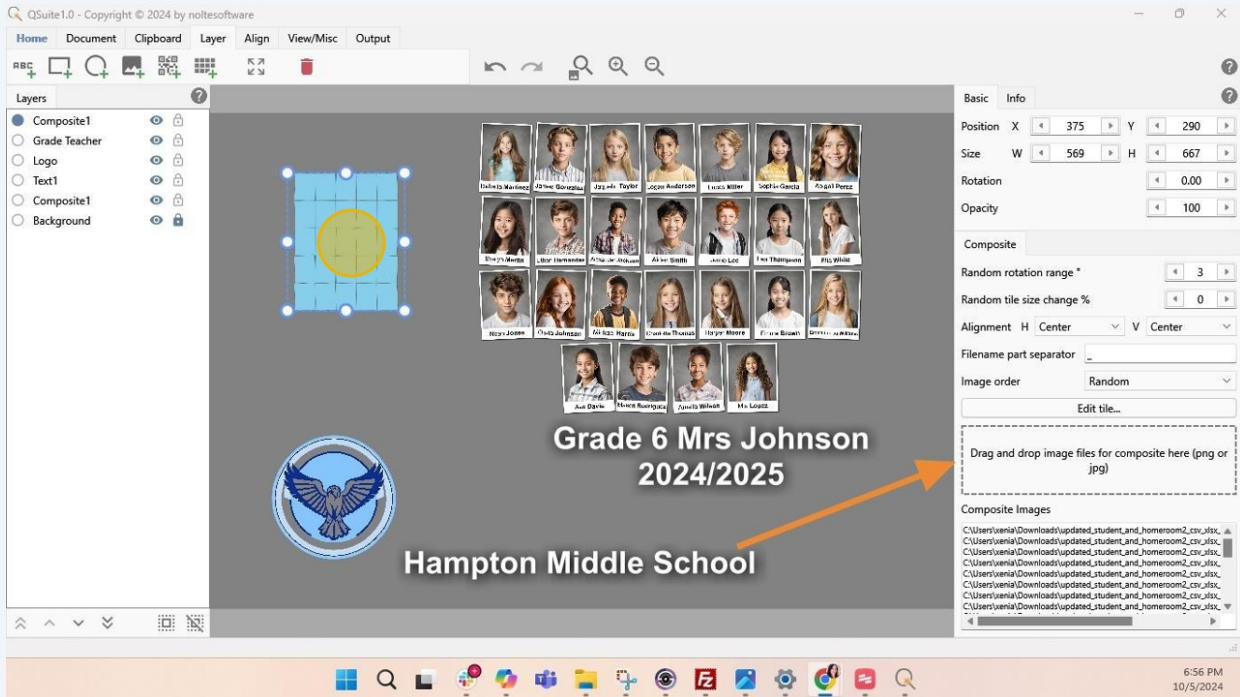

Ensure the file name structure is firstname_lastname.



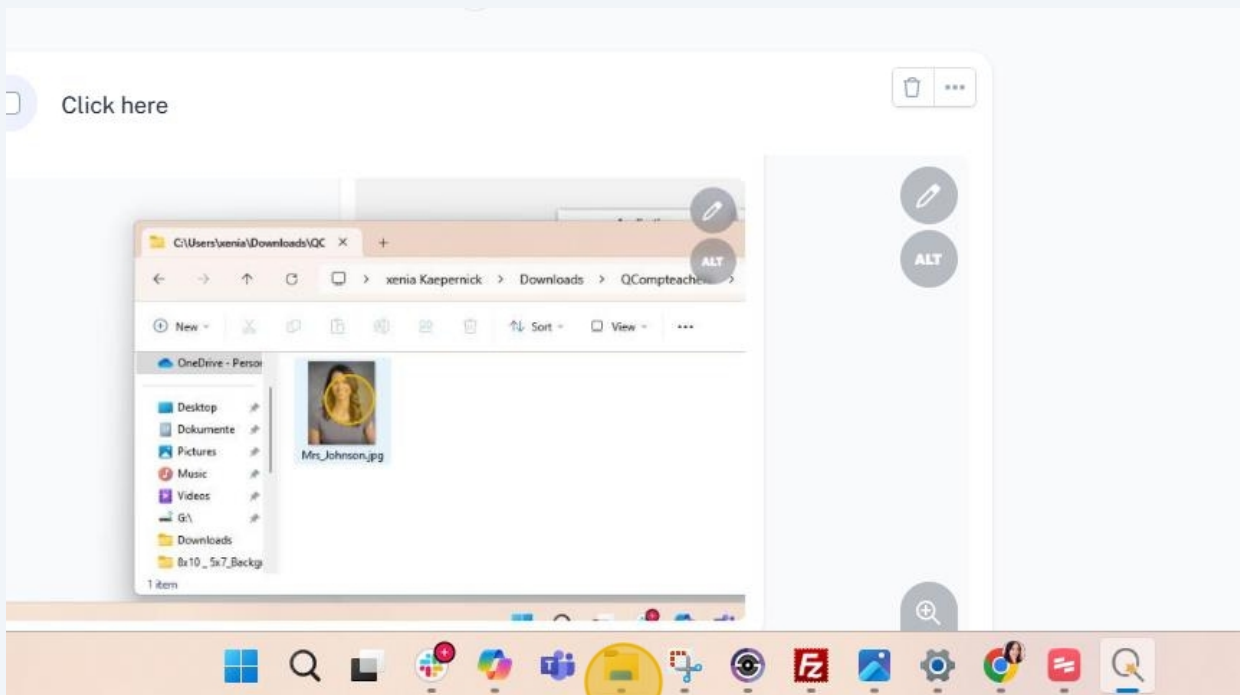

Now select the teacher composite layer. Browse for the teacher image(s) under the composite layer's properties.

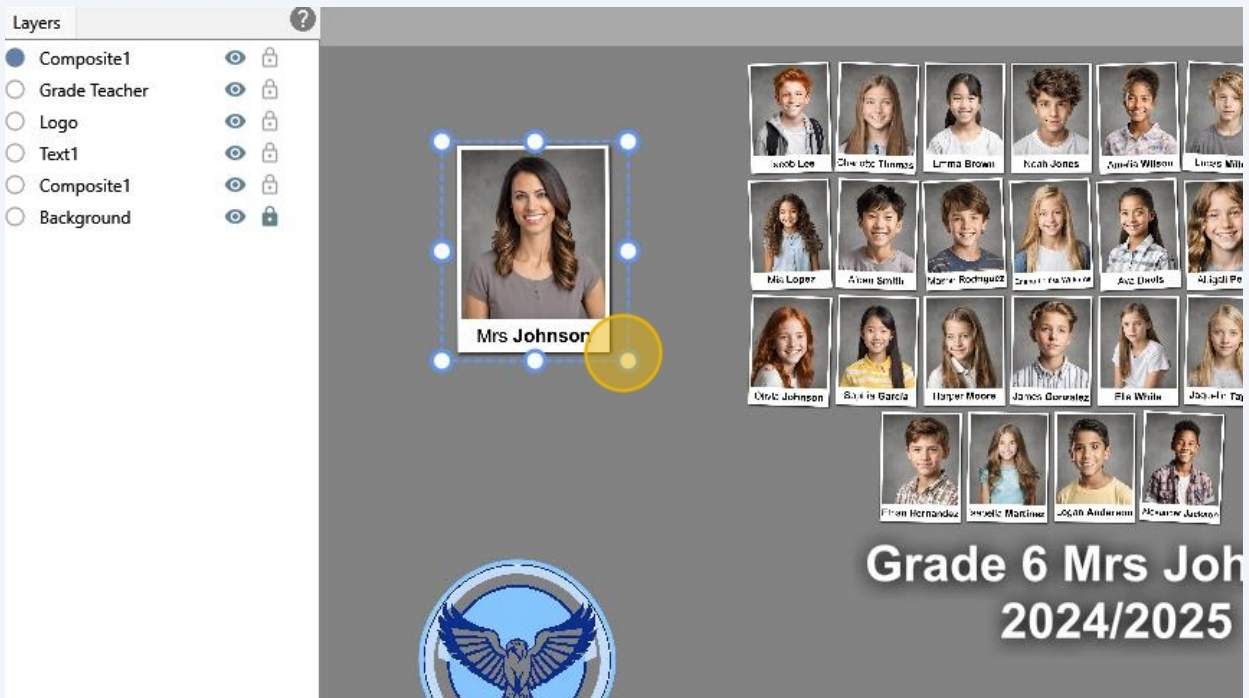

Ensure the teacher image has the right name pattern (firstname_lastname) if you display names on the composite.



10 Drag the edges of the teacher composite to your preferred position.



11 Now save the final composite to your device by clicking "Save as image".

You can now continue and use the Easy Mode to create additional composites for more classes/homerooms.
