

## **QComposite Easy Mode**













Select the QLayout file from your device. Every time you save a template under the Standard mode, it will be saved as a QLayout file.




Adjust the text layers under the text properties so it matches the current class / homeroom you're working in.






Now select the teacher composite layer. Browse for the teacher image(s)under the composite layer's properties.
